

RESERVATIONS REQUIRED

HERE WE GO AGAIN!! Let's all have a fun day canoeing and eating a picnic lunch together. First we will canoe the scenic Upper Cuyahoga River. This trip is open to all ages, families and friends. The river depth is 2 to 5 feet with a current of about 2 mph. Dam-controlled releases ensure that it is always deep enough to paddle. This short trip is about 7 miles long. It begins at US 422 and ends back at Camp Hi. Our Special Hi Rise group rate is \$22 per person in a Canoe or a Kayak. This presumes two people in one rental canoe or single person Kayak. Little kids in the middle are \$1.50 each. Also, kids 12 and under eat for \$5.

Check in with Paul between 11:00 AM and 11:30 AM at the Hi Rise Table, sign a waiver, pay your fee and leave your car keys at the desk. Get fitted for your life vests and paddles, take your cooler and board the Camp Hi bus with Paul. Two to three hours later you will be back at Camp Hi.

Don't have a partner? No problem. Rent a very stable kayak. Afterwards, we'll have burgers, dogs, chips, salads and pop in our reserved pavilion. Lynne always brings something homemade & Bob Mac cooks the burgers and dogs. Bring your own beer for discrete consumption on the river.

Kids and grandkids are welcome. A hat, sunglasses, sunscreen and something to drink are important; maybe a rain jacket just in case and gloves if you are prone to blisters. A waterproof dry bag for your wallet and camera would be a good idea too. Sandals or old tennis shoes are best in the canoe. The clothes you wear will get wet and muddy while canoeing so leave a clean change of clothes in your car. Dogs are permitted in the canoes. They love the water.


1480 east to US422 east to SR44 exit

Take SR44 south (turn right at bottom of ramp) approximately 5 miles to SR82 Turn east (left at Marathon station) on SR82 and go 2.5 miles to Abbott Road Turn north (left) on Abbott, Camp Hi is one mile north on the west (left) side of the road

Drive past the check-in building on your left and down to the parking area on the left.

From the East Side (almost one hour) I271 north or south to US422 east to SR44 exit Follow directions beginning with line two above





On Saturday, July 23, 2016, The Cleveland Metro Ski Council will host the Fifteenth Annual CMSC Metro Cup Golf Outing at Punderson State Park Golf Course and Lodge in Newbury, Ohio, featuring golf, lunch, chicken and rib dinner, refreshments, prizes, and great fun!

In this golf outing CMSC Ski Clubs compete in five divisions for the "Metro Cup", a rotating trophy emblazoned with winning team names. The competitive events include: Men's Medal, Women's Medal, Best Ball, Coed Scramble and Four Person Scramble. The Best Ball and Four Person Scramble teams may be all male, all female, or any combination thereof. Points are awarded in each division, first through last place. The club that accumulates the most points wins the Metro Cup! There is also a rotating trophy for the winning Four Person Scramble Team. First place winners in each division will get a "gold" medal commemorating their win. **NEW THIS YEAR! Golfers over 70 may elect to hit from the <u>Senior Tees</u>.**

To enter a *complete* team your club needs 10 golfers, with an entry in each of the five divisions. However, each club may enter any one or combination of the five events and be eligible for club points and prizes. Prizes are also awarded for skill shots and some not so skillful shots!

Golf Package Includes: \$87 per person includes 18 holes of golf, cart, chicken and rib dinner (vegetarian available upon request), lunch, on course refreshments, prizes, and fun. A keg of beer will be tapped and available to all participants immediately following golf. Post golf refreshments and dinner take place at the scenic lakeside Punderson State Park Lodge. If you want dinner only, the cost will be \$30.00.

Registration is at 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM at the Pro Shop Deck; Team organization is 12:30 PM to 1 PM; and shot gun start is at 1:00 PM.


