As we progress in life we are always put into positions that we must adapt due to changes. When I first joined Hi Rise 19 years ago we met at a hall in Euclid that the club had been using for years and within 2 or 3 years we lost the use of the facility as they were getting rid of the hall. At that time we found the Knights of Columbus hall on Vine Street in Willowick that we nicknamed "The Dungeon" it was below ground level with no windows and a slight stench to it. We managed to stay there for about 5 or 6 years before the property was sold (or condemned as it should have been).

Hi Rise then moved our meetings across Willowick Drive to the American Legion Hall that we enjoyed for about eight years. We are one of the few clubs to have our own meeting location (most meet at local bars or restaurants like we do in the summer) and enjoy the luxury of privacy, being able to supply our own beverages, cook whatever food we want to provide or have cooking contests, turkey bowling as well as beer and wine tasting nights. And we have Russell Thompson, Bartender and Manager extraordinaire!

We had a really good deal with the legion, meeting there 16 times a year and giving them income to run the facility, unfortunately they have not done a good job of managing themselves are now desperate to prevent their branch from shutting down. Last year our rent increased by 50 percent and they want at least that much more for this year plus we would have to buy all beverages from the bar and we would not be able to cook anything as they have a catering manager now running the place. You may remember last year we had made arrangements with an alternative hall in Mentor but negotiated a deal to keep as at the legion for one last year. This year we will not be going back.

Your board has found another location less than a quarter of a mile away on Vine Street, **The VFW Hall** that is hidden behind the Shop and Save Grocery Store across Vine Street from Walmart. (See attached map) There are going to be more changes unfortunately. We are not allowed to bring in our own alcohol and must purchase it from the bar. Draft beer is \$1, bottle beer, wine and shots are \$2 each with premium shots being \$3. This pricing is much less than your normal restaurant prices such as Pub 91. We will be able to continue supplying our own soft drinks, water, munchies and have use of the kitchen. The hall itself is much smaller but will be more intimate. We are welcome to use the front door (which is the driveway side of the building) or the small glass door in the back which leads directly into our room. We may not have this option available on the colder nights. They only

have one set of washrooms that are by the bar.

Admission price is being reduced from the current \$5 to \$3 for members and \$4 for guests.

Our tradition is to have hot dogs at our first meeting which we will continue and as a special treat for the new hall the FIRST MEETING WILL BE FREE, courtesy of you board. See you all September 28th!! We look forward to this new beginning with you, our Hi Rise friends!

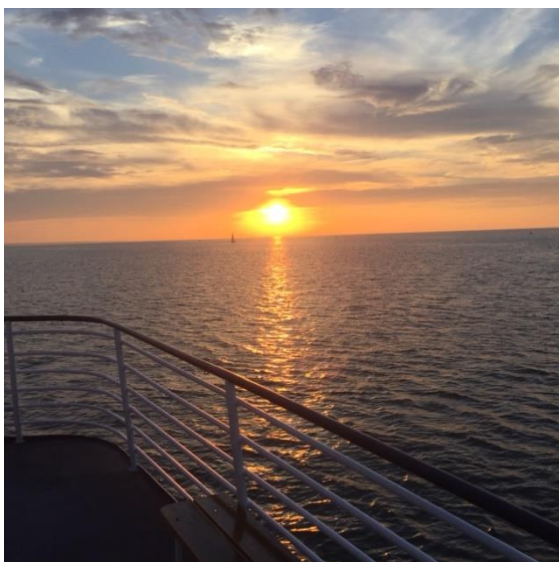

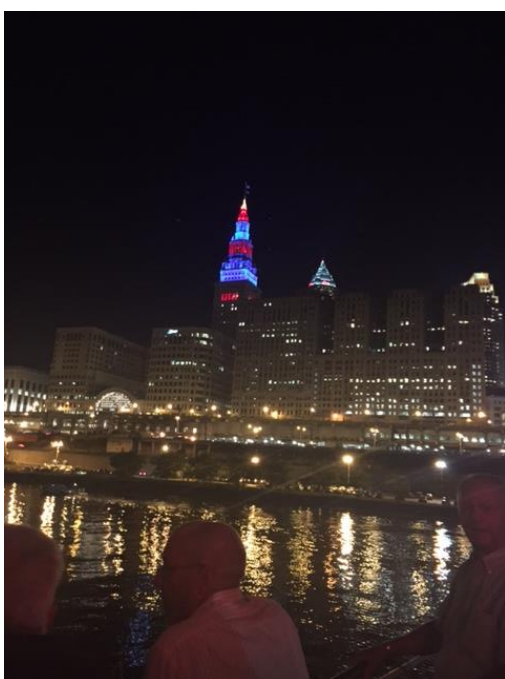
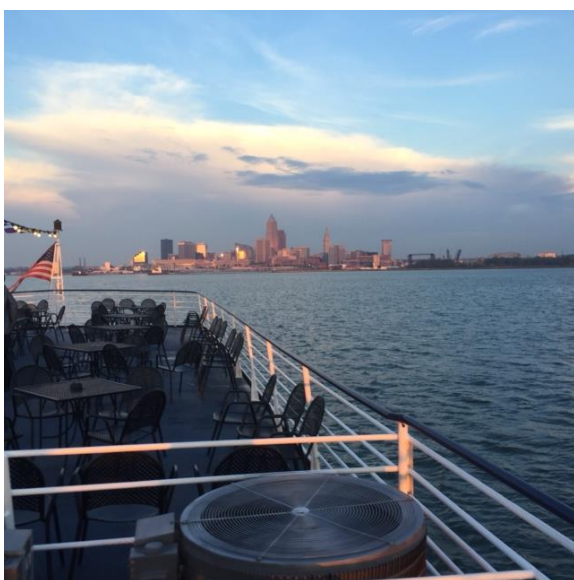
Nautica Queen Dinner Cruise enjoyed by all!
