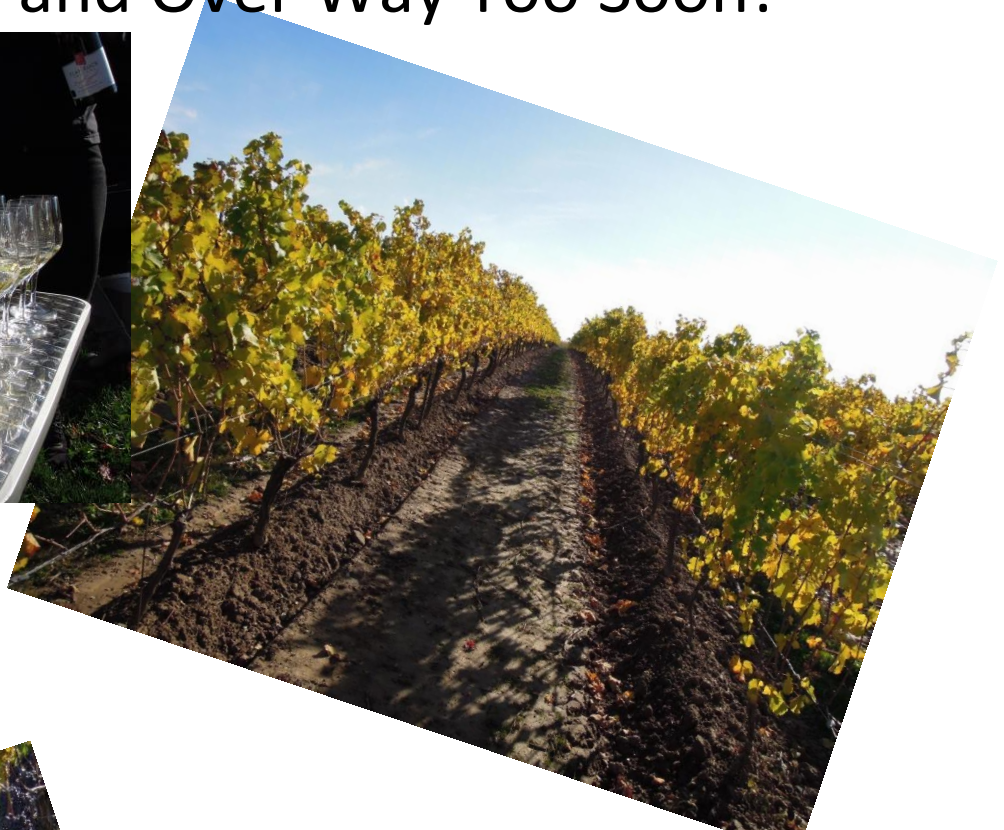

Membership: You must be a member of Hi Rise to race on our team. Contact Guy, Rick or Kerry Troy (our membership chair)

Race Schedules: Are available at meetings, in our Newsletter, on our Website (www.HiRiseSkiClub.com) , or the CMSC website.

Advance Registration: Forms are available at meetings or on our website. Hi Rise will pay the race fees for those team members who advance register for and participate for 5 or more races. Otherwise: you pay \$18.00 per race.

Trips: Hi Rise bus trips are planned for Swain 1, Bristol (combined) and Swain 2. Plus a free-skiing Friday trip to Holimont. Please support our trips!

Class Changes: If you wish to change classes—to or from “vets”, you must do so through Guy or Rick. Do not contact CMSC on your own. Change requests must be submitted at least 7 days before a race.

Qualification: For new racers or someone who has not raced in CMSC for over a year. Ski and Snowboard racers can qualify at Boston Mills on any of the three Wednesday Nights: January 4th, 11th, or 18th, 2017. Or you may qualify at any regular race. Raced before but missed last season? Then you automatically qualify into your last race class, subject to re-evaluation.

Skier Combined: The skier combined race is at Bristol Mountain. To be eligible, you must have two races completed before then. If one or more races prior to Bristol are cancelled, this could change. NO LATE RACE DAY SIGN UP. ADVANCE REGISTRATION ONLY.

Snowboard Combined: The Snowboard Combined race will be at Swain 2. You must have at least one snowboard race completed before then. NO LATE RACE DAY SIGN UP. ADVANCE REGISTRATION ONLY FOR BOARDERS.

Work Assignments: For each race, one third of our registered racers may be assigned to work that race. Work assignments are posted in the bib pick-up area. It is your responsibility to check the schedule. If you are assigned to work, please show up for your assigned post at least 15 minutes before the scheduled race start time. Gatekeepers report to the race start area. Should you prefer to work or not work at a particular race, let Guy or Rick know at least one week before that race. RACERS WHO ARE ASSIGNED TO WORK AND FAIL TO DO SO ARE DQ'ED.

Gatekeeping: this is probably the most difficult work assignment. Although we try to assign more experienced racers to this job, sooner or later...your turn will come.

Ask Guy or Rick, or any of our long term racers how to gatekeep. Also: see the CMSC Race Rules under "disqualifications" and "Gatekeepers".

REMINDERS:

Helmets must be worn by all racers for all races.

UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT: This rule has been around for a year or so. However, due to some recent incidents it will be watched more closely. A moderate "f" bomb after a crash or bad run might be tolerated. Loud, continuous cursing and equipment tossing will get you DQ'ed and even suspended from one or more future races.

No BYOB: Please do not bring your own booze into the ski area lodges, especially Peak-n-Peek, Boston Mills, and Snow Trails.

Shot Bag: On the other hand, this tradition can continue with some DISCRETION. Hi Rise is responsible for the bag at Boston Mills. Any volunteers for this important task will be appreciated.

Lift Tickets: Some of the ski areas offer a discount for racers. A few may require you to show your bib in order to get the CMSC price.

DQ and Race Time Sheets: Showing racer times and DQ's are usually posted in the bib pick-up area or awards area about an hour after the last race. It is your responsibility to check to verify times and DQ's. If you dispute the time or a DQ, find Guy or Rick to discuss the matter and, possibly, file a protest.

Course Inspection: Unless otherwise instructed by a CMSC race official or ski area race crew, you may slide slip a course or snow plow (one gate at a time). Do not shadow or ski the course.

Standard Race Order:

EXCEPT FOR BRISTOL'S Super G RACE, the race order will be as follows:

Group 1: Super Vets, AAVM, AAW, AAM, AVW, AVM, AW, AM, AQ

Group 2: BBVM, BBW, BBM, BVW, BVM, BW, BM, Sr Vets, CCVM, CCVW, CCW, CCM, CCQ.

Boarders: BBSB, BSB, CCSB, CSB, SBQ

Attention Boarders, there are now four classes: BB, B, CC, and C. Also, boarders will race GS and SL courses at Bristol Combined (but not Super G).

Holiday Valley Race Hill: For most races, we will be on Foxfire to the right of Cindy's Run Chair Lift. Except, Holiday Valley 1 on Sunday: Groups 1 and 2 are on Edelweiss. Holiday Valley's NASTAR is being moved to Foxfire.
