Thanks to Hi Rise Ski Club, I've had the thrill of skiing in the Rocky Mountains. I've been as far north as Golden, British Columbia to ski at Kicking Horse Mountain. At one point in time, I served as the Trip Chairperson and really enjoyed the experience. Being a member of Hi Rise Ski Club has enabled me to travel to some out of the way places...all the time enjoying being with my friends.



through the years, we all travelled and looked out for each other. We learned many details about the geology of the canyon (DUDE the Grand Canyon Rocks: deposition, uplift, down cutting, erosion) and shared some great experiences during that trip (Squirrel!!!!) that you just wouldn't believe.

The hike back to the top of the south rim of the Grand Canyon was via the Bright Angel Trail, a much more temperate environment with equally spectacular views. The return trip back up to the top was a lot easier than the descent into the canyon.

Thanks to my friends Pam Korenewych, Geri Weis and Pete Snitzer the MOST memorable trip I've enjoyed so far has been my hike to the bottom of the Grand Canyon in October, 2010. We hiked down into the canyon via the South Kaibab trail (desert environment) and spent two nights at The Phantom Ranch. This was not a club sponsored trip, but thanks to the friendships that developed amongst the 4 of us

RESERVATIONS REQUIRED

Hi Risers prepare to get wet, have fun and eat a big picnic lunch after spending an afternoon canoeing the scenic Upper Cuyahoga River. This trip is open to all ages, families and friends. The depth is 2 to 5 feet with a current of about 2 mph. Dam-controlled releases ensure that the Upper Cuyahoga is always deep enough to paddle. This short trip is about 7 miles long. It begins at US 422 and ends back at Camp Hi. Our group rate is \$20 per person canoeing or for a single person Kayak. This presumes two people in one rental canoe. Little kids in the middle are \$1.50 each. Also, kids 12 and under eat for \$5.

This is a group event so be at Camp Hi between 11:00 AM and 11:30 AM.

☐ Check in, sign a waiver, pay your fee and leave your car keys at the desk.

☐ Get fitted for your life vests and paddles, take your cooler and board the Camp Hi bus. Two to three

hours later you will be back at Camp Hi.

Don't have a partner? No problem. Rent a very stable kayak. Afterwards, we will have burgers, dogs, chips, salads and pop. Camp Hi has a pavilion reserved for our picnic. Bob Mac cooks the burgers and dogs; there will be other tasty treats sides to enjoy too! Bring your own beer for discrete consumption.

Kids and grandkids are welcome. They will have a blast! Water balloons and squirt guns are common accessories. A hat, sunglasses, sunscreen and something to drink are important; maybe a rain jacket just in case and gloves if you are prone to blisters. A waterproof dry bag for your wallet and camera would be a good idea too. Sandals or old tennis shoes are best in the canoe. The clothes you wear may get wet and muddy while canoeing so leave a change of clothes in your car. Dogs are permitted in the canoes.

Turn east (left at Marathon station) on SR82 and go 2.5 miles to Abbott Road

Turn north (left) on Abbott, Camp Hi is one mile north on the west (left) side of the road

Drive past the check-in building on your left and down to the parking area on the left.

From the East Side (almost one hour)

I271 north or south to US422 east to SR44 exit
