

#### CMSC Metro Cup Edition 16 By Bob Maclauchlan

If you can remember back to July 22<sup>nd</sup>, it was a wet morning –a very wet morning. The afternoon forecast was optimistic claiming that the weather would clear up in time for our 1PM shotgun start. Numerous members of the Hi Rise team contacted me to see if the event was going to happen or not. Although earlier 50% of the greens were covered everyone showed up and competed for the Metro Cup.

A total of 92 golfers or whatever you wanted to call us teed it up in the damp conditions representing Beaver Valley, Continental, Fagowees, Warren and ourselves. We were fortunate and only saw the occasional rain drop during our round of 18 holes. This was the 16<sup>th</sup> year of the event, Continental has won it 10 times and Hi Rise has won it 6 times including our victory this year.

Hi Rise had 92 points; Continental was second with 82 points only 6 ahead of Fagowees. Beaver Valley had 16 points and Warren was DFL with 5. We also had a great turnout bringing 28 golfers to Punderson.

Individually Hellen Collins led us by winning Women's Medalist by 5 strokes shooting a solid 92. In Men's Medalist, Rick Smelko got edged out by 1 stoke ending second with a 77. We had three Co-ed scramble teams entered, Joe Tominc and Becky Bertuzzi shot a 75 but came second after losing the tie-breaker. Mike Stewart and Janice Todd were third with a 75 followed by Dan and Penny Kirby in fifth position shooting 88.

There were four teams entered in 2 Person Best Ball, where 2 golfers play each hole and they use the best score for the team. Dr. Bob and Larry Crookshanks shot 88 for third place, Guy Nerren and Jerry Collins were at 90 for fourth. Michael Shon and Dennis Kutash edged out Greg and William Schmid winning the tie breaker for 5<sup>th</sup> place, both teams shot 92.

We entered three teams in the 4 person scramble, here all four in the group take a shot and you then hit next from where the best shot landed. Third place and 1 stroke out of first were Harry West, Bill Starr, Pat Melio and Bob Maclauchlan at 66. Coming in fourth with an impressive 67 was Dave, Jason, Justin Crookshanks and Denver Wolf. Coming in 9<sup>th</sup> was the team of Jessie Anderson, Curtis Bell, Al Hook and Jeff Grubb carding a 76, this was the first time in 3 years that Curtis' team didn't finish DFL.

After the day of golf we retired to Punderson Manor to enjoy refreshments, corn hole and a great buffet dinner highlighted with chicken and ribs before the award ceremony. We had some individual skill shot winners including Helen Collins, Greg Schmid, Joe Tominc, (Closest to pin 2<sup>nd</sup> shot) Harry West (Closet to pin #9) and myself (Longest putt made) Hopefully I didn't miss anyone. We also had some raffle winners, Helen Collins (Golf Bag), Harry West and others
