Lake Erie Shore Wine Tour

Dennis and Carol Rosa hosted another successful wine tour. This year AIH teamed up with Hi Rise Ski Club to visit the Erie Lake Shore and Islands Wineries.

We met at Great Lakes Mall parking lot for a continental breakfast before boarding a bus at 8:00 am. While in transit Dennis & Carol raffled off over 2-cases of various wines, chocolates, and wine accessories. Thanks to all who donated gifts.

Our first stop Mon Ami Winery where 33 club members sat down to 5-wine tastings from semi-dry whites & reds to sweet whites & reds. The winery had a long history of activity since 1879 before it became the winery.

Next stop Rocky Point Winery in Marblehead, Ohio. This building was once an elementary school and was renovated in 2017 as a winery. Here under a backyard canopy with a built-in bar. Attendees sat down to 6-samples of wines. After the tasting we broke out for lunch. Everyone brought everything from light snacks, mini sandwiches, casseroles and deserts. The favorite was the gourmet cupcakes. Yum!

After lunch we traveled to Vermillion Valley Winery in Wakeman, Ohio. The owner at 24 years young began his love for agriculture and purchased this vineyard in 2009. He and his wife presented several whites and reds (Cabernet, Pino Noir). Although his winery is small in nature his dream is to grow this vineyard and compete with the many other Ohio wineries. All grapes are grown on his 50acres of land.

Next stop the Paper Moon Winery in Vermillion, Ohio. Like many Ohio wineries they are family owned. Their family has been in agriculture since his great grandfather who was a dairy farmer that was passed along to his grandfather and father. After many successful business years, owner son began his venture into a winery. The winery named after the famous Ella Fitzgerald song "Paper Moon." This boutique winery several whites and reds. We tasted Riesling, Cayuga, Cabernet and a Zinfandel.

Our final stop after all the wine tastings we returned to Lake County for dinner to Vittorio's Buon Appetito Restaurant in Wickliffe, Ohio. Dinner served family style

starting with salad, then, chicken piccata, cavatelli, roasted potatoes, green beans almandine and a slice of their lemon custard cake for dessert.

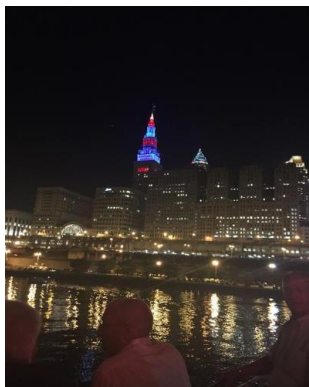

Alterra Mountain Co. to Acquire Solitude Mountain Resort

The Vail Resorts rival will own a total of 13 ski resorts across the country.

Alterra Mountain Company announced today that it will acquire Solitude Mountain Resort in Utah. [Solitude](#) will be the 13th ski resort purchased by the recently formed Alterra Mountain Co., and the 26th resort added to the company's Ikon Pass. Solitude will join a portfolio that includes [Deer Valley](#), [Mammoth Mountain](#), [Steamboat](#), and others.

"With its close relationship with Deer Valley Resort, Solitude Mountain Resort is a natural fit for [Alterra Mountain Company](#), and a tremendous addition to our family of destinations," said Alterra CEO Rusty Gregory in a [press release](#). "We are especially excited to expand our reach within Utah and offer another ski and [snowboard](#) experience in a state known for its exceptional snow and mountain culture."

In 2014, the former owners of [Deer Valley](#) purchased [Solitude](#) shortly after [Vail Resorts](#) acquired the nearby [Park City Mountain Resort](#). In 2017, when Alterra Mountain Co. [announced it would be purchasing Deer Valley](#) but not Solitude, it was unclear what would happen to the gem of Big Cottonwood Canyon—until today.

"Joining the impressive group of Alterra Mountain Company destinations places Solitude Mountain Resort in a strong position to continue to grow and enhance the brand and culture that is Solitude," said Kim Mayhew, General Manager of [Solitude](#), in a press release. "We are excited about the opportunities this transaction will create for our guests, our staff, and for our community in Big Cottonwood Canyon."

The terms and financial details of the acquisition of Solitude were not disclosed by Alterra Mountain Co., but the transaction is likely to close before the 2018-19 ski season starts. Details about how Solitude will be included on the [Ikon Pass](#) will soon follow.
