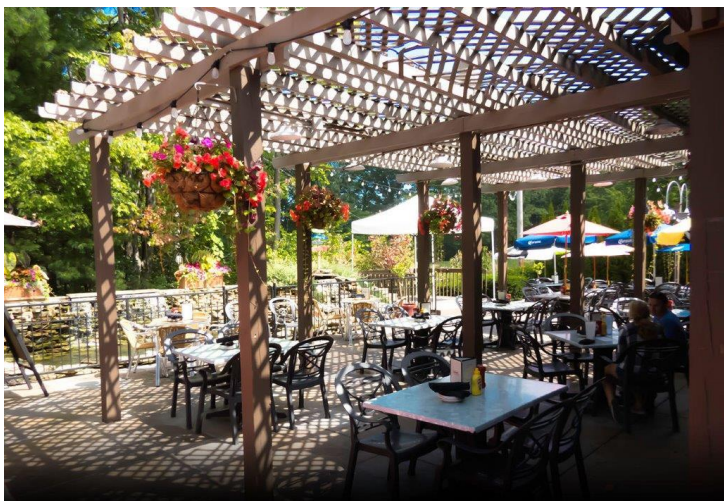
Thanks again to the board for keeping the club on track and making us one of the more successful clubs in the Cleveland area.
