## 2021 Metro Cup Wrap Up

Looking back at the Metro Cup in 2019, the event's weather was a scorcher--reaching 94 degrees plus the humidity; this year we would have welcomed the heat. It wasn't cold but the Punderson Golf Course received 4" of rain in 4 days and it was raining Saturday right until we started the outing. Kip, the club professional told us about how wet the course was and he was only open for our event so stay on the cart paths or we would cause a lot more damage to the course. There was water everywhere and everyone had wet feet in the first hole or two, ponds on the green, creeks in the fairways and ponds in the sand traps that were virtually unplayable. I believe that I saw one group building an arc after a couple of holes.

If you are not very familiar with golf, the elements always come into play and in conditions like this you get very little roll and the golf course plays a lot longer than normal sometimes hitting 2 or 3 clubs higher than you normally would. In the end we all finished with smiles on our faces in a reasonable time for such a large outing and cart paths only. We congregated up at the lodge for a great chicken and rib dinner before handing out the awards and Metro Cup.

If you joined us last Wednesday for our meeting at Spirits in Willoughby, you already know that we defended the cup as it was sitting on a table, newly engraved with Hi Rise as the 2021 Champions. This was the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Metro Cup event and has now been won 10 times each by Continental and Hi Rise. This year we had 34 members sign up for this tournament and help us to victory.

Rick Smelko won Men's medal playing shooting a very impressive 74 that included bogeys on both of his last two holes, winning by 10 strokes. Jessie Anderson struggled in the wet and shot 110 for second place to 103 scored by Donna from Fagowees.

Two-person Best Ball is when 2 players shot their own ball and the lowest score between them is counted on the score card. Bob Akamine and Joe Tominc claimed First Place shooting 82, winning by 4 strokes over Continental and 8 on top of Fagowees. Larry Crookshanks and Dave Stark were fifth place shooting 96 and one stroke behind with 97 were Greg Schmid and Mike Duncan.

Two-person Co-ed scramble is when a male and female each take shots and then use the best shot for their next one, Fagowees had a really good husband and wife team that shot 72, Continental, Joe and Sue Mazie were second at 80, one of the Hi rise teams, Janice Todd and Mike Stewart were tied for third with Beaver Valley at 88 but lost the tie breaker ending up 4<sup>th</sup>. Fifth place was claimed by Hi Riser's Kathy and Dave Whalen with 90 capturing a very important 10 points., Trish Carleton and Jeff Grubb ended up in 7<sup>th</sup> place.

Finally, the most popular event with 11 teams, 44 players is the 4-person scramble where all four members take a shot and continue to use the best one until they sink it in the hole. This event can have some very low scores most years but mother nature won this year. Continental won this year with a 67 (5 under par) and second place was taken by Hi Rise with my "performers of the year" Jen Williams, Laura Pomazal, Robert and Alex Mosteller one shot back at 68. (Talking about shots, Jen and Laura also had really nice shots of bourbon!) Third place from Hi Rise was the team of Harry West, Bill Starr, Ben Aveni and Bob MacLauchlan at 69. Denver Wolf, Dave Justin and Jason Crookshanks captured 7<sup>th</sup> place beating out another Hi Rise team consisting of Guy Nerren, Curtis Bell, Michael Shon and Cesare Frabotta with 77. Tenth place, but not DFL was Andy Goetz, Terry Radford, Jim and David DiFrangia with a fun filled 83.


