Trip to Lake Tahoe, February 26th to March 5th, 2022

Back in the 80's and 90's Hi Rise regularly ran multiple, successful Western trips each year. As trip chairperson, I had a personal goal to offer our members a second multi day trip in the same ski season. Of course, back in the 20th century it was simple when clubs were much larger and travel for larger groups was much easier to coordinate. Since Whitefish sold out so quickly, we looked at offering this weeklong trip to Tahoe where we haven't been for 16 or 17 years. Special thanks to the 40 members that helped to sell out our trip to Whitefish this coming January; it was because of this early sellout we have decided to put together a smaller second trip to for 20 people.

As is always the route, we fly into Reno, take a bus into Tahoe and ski a different resort each day, (for those Hi Riser's on that trip mentioned earlier, who could EVER forget Gabe, our ski safari bus driver). Vail's Epic Pass came along a few years ago offering skiing at Heavenly, NorthStar and Kirkwood on a single pass. The price for the pass was very reasonable, but having that Epic Pass, made skiing more expensive and less convenient to ski other Tahoe resorts such as Squaw Valley (Squaw wasn't included on the Epic Pass).

Several years later the mergers of the resorts and their holding companies has grown where to get an economical trip you have to go with either the Epic or Ikon passes. With that in mind and that our local ski hills (Boston Mills, Brandywine and Alpine Valley) are on the Epic pass we decided to offer this trip that features the Epic pass resorts.

The Hi Rise Lake Tahoe trip includes: round trip airfare, round trip airport transfers to Tahoe and hotel rooms at The Harveys Resort Casino in Nevada, which is located a couple of hundred yards from the Heavenly gondola for the price of \$1,150.

Lift tickets are not included in this price as there are many options you can customize for the amount of skiing you anticipate doing. This is a great option if you already have or are getting an Epic pass. However, if you don't have one there are a few "levels" to consider and I recommend you do your homework to find the pass that best suits you. Daily lifts ticket prices could range from \$144 in advance to \$177 at the ticket window. If you want to buy an Epic Pass you can get it from our tour operator and get a discount on the trip. Discounts are: Full Epic Pass \$50, Local Pass \$40, Epic 4 Day pass \$25. I can get you the link for buying these tickets so you get the discount directly off of the \$1,150 cost.

The passes for the pricing I'm explaining below must be purchased by Sunday September 5th (This Sunday) pricing goes up 20% on Monday September 6th. (Happy Labor Day!)

The full Epic Pass is just under \$783 with fill access to all resorts at all times. The Local pass has a few more limitations but the primary one is that it can't be used on holidays, Christmas, MLK, Presidents Day etc. cost is \$583 Both of these are good if you plan on skiing at lot at the local resorts or are going on another trip where the passes are good. There is also an Epic 4-Day pass, \$323 good at all resorts plus \$81 per day for extra days.

There is also a Tahoe Value Pass, Adult 19-64 \$423, Seniors 65+ \$359 which is good for all three resorts and may be the best value if you're just planning to ski here on this trip or returning to the area more than this trip. If you have any questions on these passes contact me but please do your homework on what works best for your situation. Visit www.epicpass.com for more info including military and college passes.

At the time of this newsletter, we have commitments from 12 skiers for this trip, leaving only 8 spaces. We'll see you in Tahoe.
