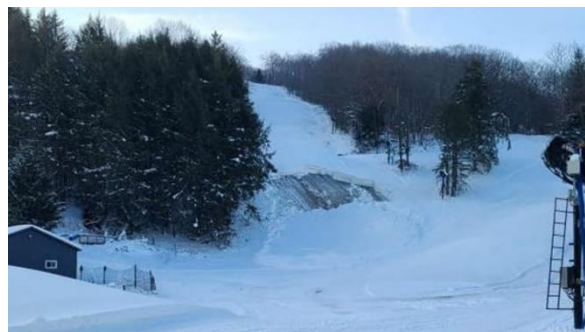
An Avalanche at Holimont?
