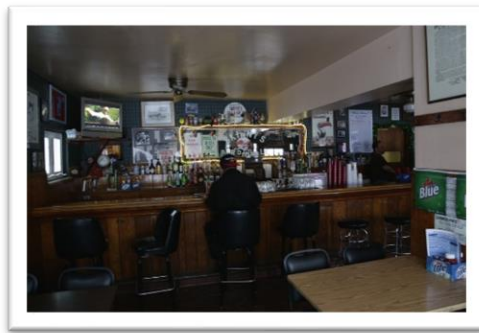
# More Upcoming Events

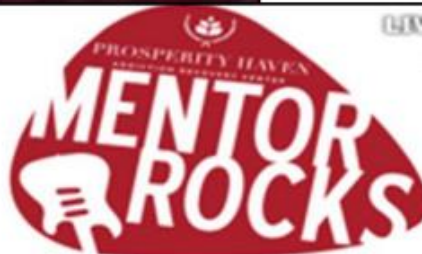
