# Hi Rise Trip to Sonoma California Wine Country

# Potential September 22, 2024, Social Trip – We need to gauge member interest (quickly!)

We need to determine if there is enough interest to run a trip to Sonoma California Wine Country. Check out the wine map and info at <a href="https://winefolly.com/deep-dive/sonoma-wine-map/">https://winefolly.com/deep-dive/sonoma-wine-map/</a>

We are looking for 20 people to fill the trip. We have two potential scenarios.

The first is a 5-day option departing on Sunday 9/22/24 flying into San Francisco Airport that morning and returning on Friday, 9/27/24.

Hotel: Dry Creek Inn Healdsburg, California 2- Queens or a King room, King is more \$

Transportation: Pure Luxury 23-26 passenger limo for the duration of trip, including airport.

Tour of Coast, welcome party, 6 wine tastings in Sonoma, Russian River and the Dry Creek Valley, Two included lunches, State Park tour- Armstrong Woods, Food and Wine paring, Olive Oil tasting, cooking class and dinner.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> scenario is the 6-day option staying Friday and returns on Saturday 9/28/24.

The itinerary is the same as above, plus one-night additional Hotel stay, extra day of transportation, plus 2 additional winery visits, one additional lunch, added Cheese tasting at a Sonoma dairy farm We will visit both Calistoga, Ca. for lunch and St, Helena, Ca. for shopping and dinner. These two towns are in the northernmost tip of the <u>Napa Valley</u> wine region.

A summary of the total costs on the 5-day option ranges from \$2,600 pp for United flights and 2 queen room to \$2,320 pp for the Southwest flight option. King rooms are higher priced and flight **prices will vary until booked**.

On the 6-day scenario- total prices range from \$3,100 pp for the United flights and the 2 queen room to \$2920, pp for the Southwest flight option. United are non-stop flights to and from San Francisco. King rooms are higher priced and **flight prices will vary until booked.**
