## Wine, Anyone!

Last month 50+ Hi Risers and Vino Club members crossed the border to taste some excellent Canadian wine. We visited seven wineries over two days. Earlier in the year Carol and Dennis traveled north to check out each winery and made some good choices. Tough job, don't you think? Each winery has their unique story from the Italian, German, or Polish immigrants who established vineyards in the new world to the young wine maker who tried several varieties of grapes before he landed on one that produced wine to his tastes.

The Niagara peninsula has ideal soil and microclimate conditions that support a wide variety of grapes. Because the regions can support many grape varieties with their own unique flavor, a wine maker can produce a wine unique to his winery. Wine making in this region has expanded over the last 25 years. Before the proliferation of vineyards on the peninsula, tree fruits like apples, peaches and cherries were the dominate crops. Today the Niagara Peninsula boasts more than 200 wineries.

If you've not been on a wine tasting adventure, here's what to expect. You are greeted by an experienced guide who give a brief introduction and history of the winery. Then you may take a tour of the wine making facility and vineyard. Finally, you are shown into the wine tasting room and served several 2-ounce glasses of their featured wine and a tasty charcuterie board. Then off to the wineshop for some wine to take home. A couple terms you'll hear on a tour are estate wine and reserve wines. Estate wines are

those wines with grapes grown in the winery's own vineyard. Reserve wines are the winery's best and sometimes their award-winning wines. It is not uncommon for a winery to purchase grapes form another vineyard and blend those grapes with their own grapes to create a signature blend. 
## Time to Renew!


