More Summertime Activities An Ohio Winery Tour & Tasting

Interested in a mid-summer adventure? Well, here it is... a one-day wine trip to three Ohio wineries! Hi Rise and the Americans of Italian Heritage Club are cosponsoring this trip to eastern Ohio wineries on Thursday, August 7th organized by Dennis Rosa. We'll travel by coach with a continental breakfast and a raffle. Participants are asked to bring a wine related items for the raffle.

Our first stop is Stonegate in Madison. This winery was built on a dream on an abandoned horse farm. Thus, the horse in the Stonegate logo. The tasting room and winery were bult from the barn after the horse stalls and manure were removed, of course. The barn was transformed into what we see today. Additionally, the vineyard was planted and cultivated to make their estate wine. To learn more about Stonegate click <u>here</u>.





Next, we'll travel to Buccia Winery just south of Lake Erie in Conneaut. Upon entering the welcoming new tasting room and we're served their award-winning estate wine. What makes this winery unique is that they only serve estate wine. Remember estate wines are those made from grapes grown on the winery's own vineyard. They proudly serve wine from the Rogers 15 variety "Agawam", bred in Massachusetts in 1856 and is available only at Buccia. At this winery you can also

check out the Buccia Bed and Breakfast. And, maybe plan a secret get away for you and your sweety! Click <u>here</u> to learn more about Buccia Winery.

For lunch at Buccia, we'll enjoy sandwiches, included in your trip price. Please bring snacks and appetizers to share for lunch.

After lunch it's off to Tarsitno Winery & Vineyard in southwest Conneaut. Tarsitno, too, was built on abandoned farm - a dairy farm. What makes this winery and

vineyard special is that it stands on the owner's great grandfather's property! Like Buccia Winery the Tarsitno Winery & Vineyard exclusively serve their estate wine from grapes originating in Italy. The climate and soil in Lake and Ashtabula counties are perfect for growing grapes, not unlike other famous wine regions around the world.





Finally, it's dinner time and back to Wickliffe's Vittorio Appetito Restaurant for a buffet style Italian dinner.




